

## EXPERT TIP:

Microsoft's developer toolbox includes a list of control IDs that we use when customizing the Office 2007 Ribbon. When creating controls in Office 2007, everything must have an "ID." If you create a new tab, group or control from "scratch," you assign the "ID" attribute whatever name you prefer. However if you want to refer to something that's already built into the application, you use an "idMso" attribute instead and pull the name from the Microsoft list of Control IDs. The list comes in the form of an executable that results in the download of 24 spreadsheets (grouped by program) with all the control IDs you need. Go to Microsoft.com and search for "control IDs."

#### It's Time to Hover
